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Major Issues in Conference:

- Senate-Only Actions. On its own, adopted trailer bill language (TBL) (1) making integrated regional waste management (IRWM) appropriations consistent with existing grant guidelines, (2) reducing and refocusing the appropriation for Delta natural communities conservation plans (NCCPs), there by increasing the statewide allocation, and (3) reverting Propositions 1E and 84 appropriations made in SBX7 8 in order to reappropriate funding with amended control language.
- Assembly-Only Actions. On its own, adopted budget bill language (BBL) providing direction on DWR's expenditure of Proposition 84 funds for Coachella Valley Water District.

LAO Conference Compromise:

- Recommend TBL that includes all language adopted by either house, with exception of the Senate's Delta NCCP language and the Assembly's Coachella Valley Water District language.
- In general, we recommend adoption of language and actions to clarify or create consistency with existing program guidelines to allow for streamlined updates to regulations and local assistance criteria. Accordingly, we recommend the Senate-adopted TBL changes to the IRWM language and to allow for the updated control language for the Propositions 84 and 1E appropriations.
- On the other hand, we recommend denying the Senate-adopted TBL amending the NCCP local assistance process to provide specific allocations to local Delta communities and the Assembly-adopted BBL providing for the expenditure of Proposition 84 funding for Coachella Valley Water District, as these are contrary to the existing granting processes and raise policy issues that should be adjudicated in the policy process.
