Governor. Requests \$458,000 (all funds through distributed administration) and four full-time permanent positions to staff the HiAP task force. The HiAP task force is made up of 19 state agencies, departments, and offices, and is facilitated and staffed by the Department of Public Health (DPH).



Assembly. Approved as budgeted.



Senate. Denied Governor's proposal.



LAO Compromise

- **Funding.** \$458,000 in federal Preventative Health and Health Services Block Grant funds in each of 2014-15 and 2015-16. The DPH was recently informed by the federal government that it will be receiving an additional \$490,000 in block grant funds. This funds the Governor's full budget request (for two years) with an alternative more technically appropriate funding source.
- **Positions.** Four two-year limited term positions. The term of the positions would match the anticipated time the grant funds will be available.
