LAO Compromise

Adopt trailer bill language that requires Board of Governors to convene working group on performance-based allocation model for \$3.8 million in basic skills funds. Legislature to review and adopt a mechanism for implementation by 2012-13.

(X) On or before September 1, 2010, the Board of Governors (BOG) of the California Community Colleges shall convene a working group of key stakeholders, including but not limited to district, administration, and legislative representatives, on establishing an allocation model for at least \$3,814,000 in the Student Success for Basic Skills Students categorical program that is based on districts' success at improving outcomes for underprepared students. On or before March 1, 2011, the BOG shall forward one or more suggested performance-based funding mechanisms to the Legislature for review. It is the intent of the Legislature to consider those and other suggestions, and to adopt an allocation method by June 30, 2011, for implementation beginning with the *2012-13 Budget Act*.
