Working group could consider the following:

- As in the Senate, develop trailer bill language (TBL) that ties funding for greenhouse gas (GHG) emission reduction activities to measurable outcomes.
- The TBL should also include the Legislature's policy objectives, expenditure priorities, and parameters for the state's GHG emission reduction activities.
- Determine budget-year expenditures and position authority, and thus funding level, based on the above two bullets, and put all funding and position authority in the TBL.
- The TBL should provide that funding and position authority is for limited term.
- The TBL should require zero-based budget at end of limited term, with expenditures to be prioritized based on an evaluation of cost-effective GHG emission reduction strategies; zero-based budget should be presented with plan and time frame for meeting Legislature's policy objectives as established in TBL.
