Administration's current plan would result in substantial funding inequities.

- Round 1 grantees making sufficient progress would receive an average of \$44,065 per teacher.
- Round 3 grantees would receive an average of \$27,665 per teacher.
- New Round 4 grantees would receive approximately \$13,000 per teacher.



Recommend Legislature adopt a budget plan that maximizes parity among cohorts and uses all available federal funding. Such a plan would likely fund new grants before extending all existing grants.



Low demand might signal problems with program. Legislature could seek modifications that would make program less restrictive.
